Above all, to our Heavenly Father be the glory—for His


provision, for health, for love, and for the joy of expectation. We invite you to join us, to celebrate with us, and to help make Grootfontein truly special.

ONE DAY METHOD:



Burn the logs from 6am to 6pm using the 12 hour carbonizing cycle.



Process the bigger pieces of wood first, then move on to the thinner pieces.



Handle your charcoal gently to reduce fines -Avoid pressing or hitting.
